USGA AND THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES SHALL GOVERN ALL PLAY:

1. White stakes and boundary lines define out-of-bounds.
2. Water hazards are defined by yellow stakes. (USGA Rule 33)
3. Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes. (USGA Rule 33)
4. If a ball comes to rest on a maintenance road or cart path, or if the road or path interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player may lift and drop his ball within one club-length, not closer to the hole with no penalty.
5. If an artificial obstruction or stakes or cultivated tree interferes with stance or area of intended swing, relief may be taken as in Rule 4 above.

ALL PLAYERS ARE REQUIRED TO:

1. Carry a valid valid permit and be prepared to show it upon request to an authorized person.
2. Keep Pace with the group in front. Maximum of 2 hours per nine.
3. Metal spikes not allowed.

ETIQUETTE:

- Players finishing 9th hole have priority over those starting on No. 10.
- Slow players (hole open in front) or those looking for a lost ball must give way to following players.
- Each player must have a set of clubs.
- Power carts must be kept 30 ft. from greens & tees.
- CARTS NOT PERMITTED ON TEES OR GREENS.
- NO PRACTICING ON TEES, FAIRWAYS OR GREENS.
- Shirts & Shoes must be worn at all times.
